We are moving!

After 2 years of preparation, it is finally time to relocate Vetpath Laboratory to our new home in Jandakot.

The move has been planned down to the minutest detail. Our goal is to relocate efficiently and quickly to minimize any impact on our clients. The laboratory is too large to move in a single weekend and so two sections (histopathology and microbiology) will be moved first. The remaining laboratory sections will be moved two weeks later on the ANZAC day long weekend. Running a laboratory over two locations will be challenging, and we ask for your patience during these two weeks.

The Ascot lab will be open as usual on Saturday the 24th of April with the normal courier service and after hours on call

scientist being available until 10pm.

The lab will be closed from 10pm Saturday night until 10am Monday the 26th of April. There will be no Sunday opening hours and no on call service during this time.

Closure is necessary to move our equipment, including the computer server, with minimum interruption.

Resumption of normal **public holiday** service will occur on Monday the 26th of April. Couriers will not be available and the service will be operating at the Vetpath laboratory at **Murdoch University**.

Relocating a veterinary laboratory the size of Vetpath is a massive task that the entire staff have contributed to. We appreciate your understanding and patience during the moving weeks and beyond as we are settling in.
